- **Always** be suspicious.
- Ask a caller to identify themselves.
- If something doesn't feel right, don't engage - **hang up**.
- **Hang up** if a caller asks for credit card numbers, passwords and bank account details.
- **Hang up** if a caller asks you to download a program to your computer or asks to take control of your computer.
- **Hang up** if a caller asks you to send money to an account.
- **Hang up** if you're not affiliated with the company.
- If the caller identifies themselves as working for a company, make a note of it. You can call the institution back to verify.
- Legitimate financial institutions should have your information, ask simple questions to which they should know the answers.
