Terms and Conditions

By entering the Morning's 'The Voice on Tour' competition ("the Competition"), you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Information on how to enter forms part of the terms and conditions. Entry into this Competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry.

WHO CAN ENTER?

- 2) The Competition is open to all residents of Australia, except employees of the Promoter and their immediate families and all companies and agencies associated with this Competition. Entrants under the age of 18 must seek parental or legal guardian consent to enter.

HOW TO ENTER

- 3) The Competition commences on Monday 14th July 2014 at 05:30 AEST and concludes on Friday 18th July 2014 at 16:00 AEST ("the Competition Period").
- 4) To enter, entrants must answer in 25 words or less who their favorite top 8 Voice star is and why and email their answer to morningscomp@nine.com.au. Entrants must also supply their full name, address, daytime contact number and preferred capital city (either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth only) to attend The Voice on Tour. A valid entry will be included in one (1) of five (5) pools of valid entries, one (1) pool for each capital city that can be nominated by an entrant (each, a "**Capital City Pool**").

AND the entry must not be, without limitation:

- a) late;
 - b) delayed;
 - c) incomplete;
 - d) incomprehensible;
 - e) unlawful;
 - f) obscene;
 - g) defamatory;
 - h) discriminatory;
 - i) libellous;
 - j) threatening;
 - k) pornographic;
 - l) harassing;
 - m) hateful;
 - n) racially or ethnically offensive;
 - o) capable of encouraging of conduct that would be considered a criminal offence;
 - p) capable of violating any law;
 - q) capable of giving rise to civil liability.
- 5) Entries must be received within the Competition Period.

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- 6) All entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter and NOT at the time of transmission by the entrant.
- 7) Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements and must be substantially unique.
- 8) Entry details remain the property of the Promoter and will not be returned to the entrant. Entrants agree to grant the Promoter a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to use, distribute, broadcast and sub-licence their entries in all media worldwide and acknowledge that they will not be entitled to any fee for such use.
- 9) The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries at anytime during or after the Competition Period, and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process (including but not limited to tampering by way of the utilisation of techniques designed to avoid the payment of postage costs) or who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. - 10) The Promoter is neither responsible nor liable for late, lost or misdirected entries, or entries not received by the Promoter for any reason whatsoever. Entrants should not send in original copies of their entries. No responsibility will be taken by the promoter in the event that the original entry is lost or damaged in editing.

PRIZES

- 11) There will be five (5) prizes awarded, one (1) prize awarded to the best judged entry in each Capital City Pool. The winner from each Capital City Pool will receive the prize detailed below.

- 12) Tickets can only be redeemed to The Voice on tour concert at the winner's nominated capital city (either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth only). A winner must be available to travel to their nominated capital city to attend The Voice on Tour concert on the specified date. If winner is unable to fulfill the prize at this time, winner forfeits the prize package with no compensation or further liability of the Promoter. Cash will not be awarded in lieu of the prize.
- 13) The location of the seats will be determined by the Promoter at its complete discretion. The Voice tour tickets is subject to the event venue and ticket terms and conditions, including any applicable age restriction. The Promoter and event organisers hereby expressly reserve the right to eject the winner (and/or his/her companion) for any inappropriate behaviour, including but not limited to intoxication, whilst participating in any element of the prize
- 14) The Promoter is neither responsible nor liable for any loss or damage suffered in the event that The Voice tour is postponed, cancelled, rescheduled or relocated for any reason whatsoever.

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- 15) The prize values are correct as at the date of printing. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for change in prize value between now and the ultimate date on which the prize is taken.
- 16) If an element of the prize consists of travel, an event, concert or other similar prize outlined above is, for any reason, cancelled, postponed, rescheduled or not available, that element of the prize will be considered as forfeited and no cash alternative offer will be awarded in lieu of the prize.
- 17) All prizes must be taken as offered. The prize, or any unused portion of the prize, is not transferable, exchangeable and cannot be redeemed as cash. The prize is not valid in conjunction with any other offer.

JUDGING

The one (1) entrant whose entry is deemed to be the most creative and original out of all valid entries received in each of the five (5) Capital City Pools will be deemed the winner of that Capital City Pool and

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receive the prize in their nominated capital city. The Competition is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner.

- 25) The prize winners will be notified by telephone and in writing using the contact details given in their entry.
- 26) The judges' decision in relation to any aspect of the Competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the result. The Promoter may in its absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a winner being notified or a winner's name being announced if it is discovered that the winner did not enter the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions. In such circumstances, an additional judging will be conducted.
- 27) The Promoter's decisions in relation to all aspects of this Competition are final and binding on all who enter and no correspondence will be entered into.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 28) All entries must be:
 - a) the original independent creation of the entrant;
 - b) owned by the entrant; and
 - c) free of any claims, including copyright or trade mark claims by other parties.
- 29) If your entry is selected as a winning entry, validation of your circumstances/ the validity of your entry will be undertaken by the Promoter. Method of validation (without limitation) will be determined by the Promoter in its complete discretion. If the winning entry is deemed to be a winner, the winner will be notified as per the terms and conditions herein. In the event that the Promoter requests the entrant to sign any legal documents relating to the verification of their medical circumstance, the legal documents will take the form determined by the Promoter.

- 34) The Promoter and its related entities (including their officers, employees and agents) will take no responsibility for defective prizes or prizes damaged or lost in transit, or late, lost or misdirected mail.
